## **Exercise scenarios**

The exercise will simulate parallel flooding on Danube and Tisa rivers, but in different tributaries and sections, requiring not only all available national assets, but also the assistance of neighbouring countries and the activation of the UCPM.

Exercise scenarios are designed to recreate the complexity of emergency situations. Overall setup, objectives and planned injects are all based on former events and the identification of local risks and hazards.

Presenting an array of emergencies from environmental threats to the evacuation and medical attendance of the affected population, scenarios are shaped to require the close cooperation of volunteer firefighters and water rescue teams, with the inclusion of national authorities and humanitarian organizations.

The setup will allow participants to test cooperation and their understanding of international standards, including Host Nation Support and coordination of volunteer assets.



## Unified flood operations in the Danube Region

The Profound Exercise project is aimed to improve the cooperation of flood response NGOs in Hungary, Slovakia and Romania, and also their neighbouring contries in the Danube Region.

Thanks to the funding received from the EU participating organizations have the opportunity to establish a common framework for training and deploying in synergy with the European Union Civil Protection Mechanism.

The project's main goal is to establish unified flood operation in the Danube Region through the following tasks:

- Identify capacities, gaps and good practices to provide necessary training for volunteers.
- Develop SOPs to meet the EU guidelines as responder or as host organization.
- Develop sustainable training programme with e-learning, training of trainers and handbooks.
